JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2012).

FACTS

- 1. That Ghent B. Holman, Jr. is the current owner ("Respondent") of a facility located at 12516 East Green Road, Mt. Vernon, Jefferson County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Mt. Vernon/Holman (2), Ghent B. Jr. (Farm).
 - That said facility is designated with Site Code No. 0818105007.
 - That Respondent has owned said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on January 22, 2014, Garrison Gross of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 5. That on <u>3-7-14</u>, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. <u>7012 0470 0001 3000 7688</u>.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Garrison Gross during the course of his January 22, 2014 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

(1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2012).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2012), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00)</u>. If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>April 14, 2014</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2012), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2012), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondents check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2012). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.



Subject: Open Dump Site Inspection at Ghent B. Holman (2), Jr. (Farm) Site

General Remarks: An Open Dump Site Inspection was conducted on Wednesday, January 22, 2014 at the property of Ghent B. Holman, Jr. The inspection was conducted by Garrison Gross representing the Illinois EPA Bureau of Land. The property address is 12516 East Green Road, in rural Mt. Vernon, Illinois, 62864. The inspection was conducted based on a complaint (C-13-134) alleging open dumping of vehicles at the site. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were overcast skies, 25° F, with a moderate breeze. Surface conditions were frozen with light snow cover.

<u>Inspection Findings</u>: The inspection began at 1:25 P.M. The inspection was initiated from the public roadway. Numerous vehicles were observed from offsite (photo 001). Vehicles were scattered along the entrance driveway and in the field around the mobile home and barn. No signs were posted indicating that an automotive business was being operated at the site. I entered the site and continued the inspection by walking and photographing the site.

Approximately forty (40) waste vehicles were observed at the site (photos 001-018 and 020-029). All of the vehicles appeared to be more than 7 years old. Some of vehicles were missing windows or doors or the windows were rolled down; others had sustained collision damage. Some of the vehicles were missing wheels, motors, or other essential parts. Most of the vehicles did not have license plates or the plates weren't current; suggesting that the vehicles hadn't been driven for some time. Most of the vehicles did not appear to be operable in their current condition. Some of the vehicles were overgrown in vegetation; others appeared to be more recently acquired.

Evidence of open burning and scavenging was observed near the barn (photo 019). What appeared to be steel braided hoses were observed in a pile. It appeared that the hoses had been burned to remove the rubber / plastic covering. Other unidentifiable metal items were in the burn pile. Approximately 600 cubic yards of waste were observed at the site. The inspection ended at approximately 1:45 P.M.

Additional Remarks: Information concerning property ownership / control was obtained through tax records available from the Supervisor of Assessment's Office in Jefferson County. Tax bills are mailed to Ghent B. Holman, Jr., 15885 North Illinois Highway 37, Mt. Vernon, Illinois 62864. The property is referred to as parcel 07-18-200-002 and contains approximately 130.86 acres. Mt. Vernon Autocars, Inc. is registered with the Secretary of State and Ghent B. Holman, Jr. is listed as the registered agent and president. The business is operated at 2603 Veteran Memorial Drive in Mt Vernon and has been issued a license by the Illinois SOS to sell used cars. The Illinois SOS license does not cover the property located at 12516 East Green Road, Mt. Vernon, Illinois.






