JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2012).

FACTS

- 1. That Jeanetta Maddock is the current owner and Gary Maddock is the current operator ("collectively Respondents") of a facility located at 6728 & 6732 South US Highway 45, Brookport, Massac County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Brookport/Maddock.
 - That said facility is designated with Site Code No. 1278600003.
 - That Respondents have owned or operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on March 26, 2014, Phillip Pierce-Savoie of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on <u>4-16-14</u>, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. <u>70/2 0470 000/ 3000 8/04</u>.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Phillip Pierce-Savoie during the course of his March 26, 2014 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2012).
- (2) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in scavenging, a violation of Section 21(p)(2) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(2) (2012).
- (3) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3)(2012).
- (4) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general construction or demolition debris: or clean construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7)(2012).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2012), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>June 10, 2014</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2012), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2012), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2012). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

This inspection was made as a follow-up to the June 29, 2011 inspection by this office. The site is located at 6728 & 6732 approximately three (3) miles north of Brookport, Illinois. The site was easily accessed by US Route 45. This inspector knocked on the door but on one answered. I was hailed by a neighbor who informed me that currently these properties were unoccupied. I then observed the property. There appeared to be more General Construction and/or Demolition Debris (GC/DD) on-site than I had observed during the previous inspection, and there were more used tires as well, though still fewer than 12 used tires. The GC/DD was scattered over the lawn between the two properties as well as piled into three piles visually estimated to be about 4 yards by 4 yards by 2 yards each. Open burning had occurred at the site, as was evidenced by scorched soil and partially combusted materials including neatly layered tire beads, food and beverage cans, and dimensional lumber. Wiring harnesses were stockpiled on a bucket near this open burning area. Records at the Massac County Assessor's Office showed that these properties are owned by John and Jeanetta Maddock. Further research revealed that Mr. John Maddock had passed away, leaving Ms. Maddock as the sole owner of record.






