1 MR. MCCAMBRIDGE: Let's go on the record.

2 This is a hearing in Identical-in-Substance
3 Rulemaking R14-16, in the matter of Definition of VOM
4 Update, USEPA, regulations July 1st, 2013 through
5 December 31st, 2013. This is based on some USEPA
6 exemptions from the definition of volatile organic
7 material adopted by the USEPA. There was one -- I'm
8 trying to find the date right off the top. There was
9 one -- August 28th, 2013 where USEPA exempted
10 Trans-1-chloral-3,3,3-trifluoroprop-1-ene. The Board
11 took care of that and adopted an exemption in the
12 Illinois definition in the prior update which would have
13 been R14-7 I believe. Then USEPA adopted another
14 exemption on October 22nd, 2013, the exemption was for
15 2,3,3-tetrafluoropropene. That is the subject of the
16 board's March 20th, 2014 proposal for public comment
17 that appeared in the Illinois Register on April 11th,
18 2014. Public comment period extends -- I believe it
19 ends on May 24th, and the Board will promptly consider
20 adoption of the exception at the June 5th Board meeting.

21 Rolling back, the reason we're having this
22 hearing is because it could result in a SIP revision or
23 most likely it will result in a SIP revision and USEPA
24 requires that the state conduct a public hearing on any

1 SIP revision before USEPA will approve it.

2 I'm the hearing officer, my name is
3 Mike McCambridge. The attending Board member with me is
4 Jennifer Burke. That's all the people here in Chicago.

5 In Springfield, could you identify yourself?

6 MR. MATOESIAN: Sure. Charles Matoesian.

7 I'm an attorney for the Illinois Environmental
8 Protection Agency. And with me today I have Jackie Sims
9 who's a regulatory unit manager in the Bureau of Air and
10 Yoginger Mahajan who is an environmental protection
11 engineer in the Bureau of Air.

12 MS. NEWMAN: Connie Newman, Pollution
13 Control Board.

14 MR. MCCAMBRIDGE: Does the agency have
15 anything to add to the record in this? I've noticed
16 that you filed your appearance yesterday and that's the
17 only filing that I've seen. Is that true?

18 MR. MATOESIAN: Yes. We have nothing to
19 add.

20 MR. MCCAMBRIDGE: You have nothing to add
21 now?

22 MR. MATOESIAN: No.

23 MR. MCCAMBRIDGE: Okay, very good. In that
24 case, we've run down what's going to happen next on this

1 and if no one has anything to add we're going to go
2 off record.


3 Seeing that no one has anything to add, we
