JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2014).

FACTS

- 1. That Jamie & Angela Hollon are the current property owners and operators ("Respondents") of a facility located at R.R.2, Box 170A, Bassett Blacktop, Elizabethtown, Hardin County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Page, Brian & Tina.
 - That said facility is designated with Site Code No. 0690105017.
 - That Respondents have owned and operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on June 17, 2014, Maggie Stevenson of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of the inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 7-9-14, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 70/2 6470 000/ 3000 9064

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Maggie Stevenson during the course of the June 17, 2014 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2014).
- (2) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general construction or demolition debris: or clean construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2014).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2014), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>September 1, 2014</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution

Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2014), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2014), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondents' check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2014). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

General Remarks: This inspection was made as a follow-up to a complaint inspection conducted on October 16, 2013. The site is located at RR 2 Box 170A, Bassett Blacktop in rural Elizabethtown, Illinois. The site was easily visible from Bassett Blacktop. The inspection began at approximately 10:00 a.m. and concluded around 10:15 a.m. Six pictures were taken of the site. Waste observed included tires off rims, general construction demolition debris, metals, appliances, and miscellaneous debris.

Inspection Findings: I arrived at the site and observed approximately 15 tires off rim in several locations (photos 001, 003, 005). General construction demolition debris was also located in at least two locations (photos 001, 004). Weeds had grown up around the tires and construction debris. A trash dumpster was on site but the dumpster was not clearly marked with a disposal company. The mobile home located on the northwest side of Bassett Blacktop had waste remaining from the previous site inspection. The waste around this home consisted of appliances, metals, and miscellaneous debris. The mobile home located on the northeast side of Bassett Blacktop had waste accumulated in the vicinity since the previous inspection (photos 001, 003, 004, 005).

A pickup truck was loaded with metals and parked in an adjacent driveway.

Additional Remarks: The inspection was conducted from off-site and photos were taken from Bassett Blacktop. A sign was posted on the property, "Beware of Dog."

Jamie nor Angela Hollon responded to the ACWN dated October 29, 2013. The clean-up deadline given in the ACWN was April 30, 2014. Although it appeared that some effort to clean-up the site had been made, the Hollons have not contacted the Agency regarding the notice received in October 2013. The Hollons have not submitted any receipts for the proper disposal or recycling of waste evidenced at the site in October 2013.

It was also noted by satellite image that some waste has accumulated near the center of the approximately 40 acres that comprises the site (noted on the attached site map).

Summary of Alleged Violations:


