ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.K. Zalewski):

On February 28, 2014, the City of Nashville (complainant) filed a complaint against Sisco Corporation (respondent). The City complained of noise pollution from the cyclone system of Sisco’s property located at 1520 South Mill Street, Nashville, Washington County.

In an order dated June 5, 2014, the Board found the complaint failed to “contain a citation to a specific section of the Act or the Board’s regulations under which the Board may grant relief” and was therefore frivolous. City of Nashville, IL, a municipal corporation v. Sisco Corporation, d/b/a Sisco Box Corp., PCB 14-113, slip op. at 2 (June 5, 2014). Specifically the complaint cites to the source for Part 900 of Title 35 of the Board’s noise pollution regulations (35 Ill. Adm. Code 900.Subpart H) as the specific section of the Act or Board regulations being violated by respondent. *Id.* In the same order, the Board allowed complainant to file an amended complaint alleging a violation of a specific section of the Act or Board regulations being violated by respondent. The Board stated, “[a]ny such amended complaint must be filed by July 7, 2014. ...Failure to file an amended complaint before that date will subject this case to dismissal.” *Id.*

To date, complainant has not filed an amended complaint. Accordingly, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket. If complainant wishes, it may file a new complaint, which would be treated as a new case and assigned a new docket number.
