ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On August 15, 2014, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which William Ozga (petitioner) may appeal a July 25, 2014 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency denied reimbursement requested by the petitioner for cleanup of a leaking underground storage tank at 284 Main Street, Antioch, Lake County.

The Board extends the appeal period until December 2, 2014, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
