HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On October 20, 2014, the parties participated in a telephone status conference with the hearing officer. On October 17, 2014, respondents filed a joint motion for protective order pertaining to the deliberative process privilege. A ruling will be made before depositions begin tomorrow at 11:00 a.m., so any response and reply need to be filed by 7:00 a.m. tomorrow.

Respondent Village of Caseyville (Village) reports that the Village Clerk will be out of town on the hearing date. The Village Clerk is not excused from attending the hearing. However, if he will not be in attendance, his evidence deposition will be admitted at hearing.

Petitioner Roxana Landfill, Inc. (Roxana) agreed to submit discovery documents to respondents later today with the understanding that more may be provided when Roxana decides how it will proceed at hearing. Petitioner Village of Fairmont City (Fairmont) does not intend to produce facts or documents at hearing that relate to respondent Caseyville Transfer Station's requests; thus, they have no documents to produce for discovery.

Unless an agreement can be reached with respondents, petitioners plan to file a motion to strike portions of the administrative record, and add other documents that allegedly should have been included. The hearing officer asked petitioners to file this before hearing if possible.
