ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On December 1, 2014, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which the petitioner may appeal an October 30, 2014, determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency denied reimbursement for certain claims associated with the cleanup of leaking underground storage tanks located at 312 South Poplar, Pana, Christian County.

The Board extends the appeal period until March 9, 2015, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
