
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.A. Burke):

Section 10(h) of the Environmental Protection Act (Act) (415 ILCS 5/10(H) (2014)) requires the Board to adopt regulations that are “identical in substance” to regulations of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA). 415 ILCS 5/7.2 (2014). Specifically, Section 10(H) of the Act (415 ILCS 5/10(H) (2012)) relates to the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). USEPA has codified the NAAQS at 40 C.F.R. 50.

The Board reserved this docket for USEPA amendments to the NAAQS that occurred during the period from July 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014. During that time period, USEPA took two actions with regard to 40 C.F.R. 50. The Board included those actions in the presently pending NAAQS update docket, R15-4, which the Board should complete in the near-future. Therefore, no action is necessary in this docket R15-14, and the Board dismisses this docket.
