JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2014).

FACTS

- 1. That George William "Bill" Collins ("Respondent") is the current owner and operator of a facility located at 10603 & 10633 Bencie Lane in rural Frankfort, Franklin County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as West Frankfort/Collins-Bencie Lane
 - That said facility is designated with Site Code No. 0558045016.
 - That Respondent has owned and operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on January 7, 2015, Maggie Stevenson of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of her inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 5. That on <u>3-4-15</u>, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. <u>7012 0470 0001 3000 5905</u>.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Maggie Stevenson during the course of her January 2, 2015 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2014).
- (2) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3) (2014).
- (3) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in Deposition of General Construction or Demolition Debris: or Clean Construction or Demolition Debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2014).

CIVIL PENALTY

On September 2, 2004, the Board found Bill Collins in violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act in AC 05-9. Because this Administrative Citation addresses a second or subsequent violation of Sections 21(p)(1), pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2014), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for that violation and pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2014), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for the violation of Section 21(p)(3) and Section 55(k)(1), for a total of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00). If Respondent elects not to

petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than March 23, 2015 unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2014), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Six Thousand Dollar (\$6,000.00) statutory civil penalty.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2014), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2014). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

Narrative Inspection Report

General Remarks: This inspection was made as the result of a complaint (C-15-005) received by this office. The site is located at 10603 and 10633 Bencie Lane in rural West Frankfort, Illinois. The site was easily accessed by Bencie Lane. The inspection began at approximately 11:30 a.m. and concluded around 11:45 a.m. Thirteen pictures were taken at the site. Open burning had occurred at the site in at least two locations.

Inspection Findings: I observed open dumped mobile homes in dilapidated condition, missing doors, windows and unleveled (photos 002, 006). They did not appear to be inhabitable. The mobile home that appeared to be lived in was missing the siding along with some insulation on the west end (photo 007). The house in photo 010 appeared to be vacant.

A bus is being used as a storage unit. Although several windows were missing in the bus, they had been boarded up from the inside and precipitation was still able to enter the bus. At least 25 unlicensed vehicles were on the property in various conditions of disrepair (photos 002, 004, 006, 007, 008, 011). There are several commercial type vehicles at the site including an ambulance, heavy duty truck with rails, a refrigerated truck and a tank type truck (propane delivery or transport). Approximately 15 tractor-trailers were at the site. One had the back doors missing and the side door was hanging loose (photo 003). There was nothing inside this tractor-trailer. It was unclear if the tractor-trailers are being used for storage or transport since none of them displayed valid license plates. One boat was observed at the site (photo 001).

Approximately 100 cylinders used in propane storage for home heating were located at the property along with other smaller cylinders and a large commercial storage tank (photos 004, 007, 008, 011, 012). General demolition debris was observed in the form of doors, windows, furnace, AC unit, dilapidated mobile homes and furniture (photos 002, 004, 006, 007, 009, 010). A large pile of general demolition debris was observed behind the small metal pole garage in photo 009).

Open burning of waste on the ground included charred metals, plastics, insulation, aerosol cans and dimensional lumber (photos 004, 005, 008). Waste tires were being stored outside off and on rims (photos 007, 009). Miscellaneous waste was strewn haphazardly throughout the areas of heavy vegetation and trees (photos 004, 006, 008, 009).

Additional Remarks: The waste at this site was transported into the site from other locations. A small amount of the waste was actually generated on-site (open burning, general demolition debris from home remodeling, etc.). The site is a scenic blight and a nuisance.

According to Franklin County Tax Assessor, Mr. Collins is not being taxed for any storage units. Addresses 10603 and 10633 are both listed with owner occupied exemptions. One parcel, 1126100009, is listed in the name of Bill and Susan K Collins. The other parcel, 1126100011, is listed in the name of George W (William "Bill") Collins.

- 3. $\sim 4 \text{ cars } X 15 \text{ CY} = 45 \text{ CY}$
- 4. \sim 14 pickup trucks X 18 CY = 252 CY
- 5. \sim 5 heavy duty trucks/ambulance X 50 CY = 250 CY
- 6. \sim 2 mobile homes X 150 CY = 300 CY
- 7. \sim 1 mobile office unit X 100 CY = 100 CY
- 8. \sim 1 bus X 100 CY = 100 CY
- 9. ~miscellaneous waste = 500 CY
- 10. \sim 100 propane tanks (500 gallon) X 950 lbs = 95,000 lbs
- 11. \sim 1 ski boat = 3,000 lbs
- 12. \sim 15 empty tractor trailers X \sim 12,000 lbs = 180,000 lbs

Approximate Totals: 278,190 lbs and 1,547 CY




AC Site Map






