JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2014).

FACTS

- 1. That Jamie and Angela Hollon ("Respondents") are the current owners and operators of a facility located at R.R.2, Box 170A, Bassett Blacktop, Elizabethtown, Hardin County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Elizabethtown/Hollon, Jamie & Angela.
 - That said facility is designated with Site Code No. 0690105017.
 - That Respondents have owned and operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on January 2, 2015, Maggie Stevenson of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of her inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on <u>3-4-15</u>, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. <u>7012 0470 0001 3000 5899</u>.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Maggie Stevenson during the course of her January 2, 2015 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2014).
- That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in Deposition of General Construction or Demolition Debris: or Clean Construction or Demolition Debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2014).
- (3) That Respondent's caused or allowed water to accumulate in used/waste tires, a violation of Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 55(k)(1) (2014).

<u>CIVIL PENALTY</u>

On August 21, 2014, the Board found Jamie and Angela Hollon in violation of Section 21(p)(1) and Section 21(p)(7) of the Act in AC 15-3. Because this Administrative Citation addresses a second or subsequent violation of Sections 21(p)(1) and 21(p)(7) of the Act, pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2014), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for each violation and pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2014), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five

Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for the violation of Section 55(k)(1), for a total of <u>Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>March 17, 2015</u> unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2014), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$7,500.00) statutory civil penalty.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2014), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2014). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

General Remarks

This inspection was made as a follow-up to the 10/16/2013 and 6/17/2014 inspections. The inspection began at approximately 11:10 a.m. and concluded around 11:25 a.m. Fourteen pictures were taken of the site. The inspection was done off-site with the exception of the water in tires photo.

Inspection Findings:

At the time of the inspection, waste was strewn haphazardly in several locations (photos 001, 002, 003, 004, 005, 011, 012). Waste consisted of white goods (photo 001), construction demolition debris (photo 005), vehicles (photo 014), boats (photos 009, 012), tires (photos 001, 002, 003, 004, 006, 007, 008, 012), 55-gallon drums (photo 003) and miscellaneous waste (photos 001-004, 011, 012). Two lived-in mobile homes are located on the property. One is at the southwest corner and the other at the northeast corner of the property. A mobile home and camper overgrown in weeds and other vegetation are also located in the northeast corner of the property.

At least 35 tires were observed during the inspection. Some of the tires were holding water. Furniture is open dumped behind the barn near the Edwards Cemetery and at the mobile home in the southwest corner of the property. There are also approximately eight 55-gallon drums behind the mobile home in the southwest corner of the property that have unknown contents. The general construction demolition debris piles near the lived-in mobile home at the northeast corner of the property remain.

Additional Remarks:

The white and green trucks in photo 0690105017~01082014-001 have been moved from the mobile home site in the southwest corner to the mobile home site in the northeast corner of the property. The three boats in photo 0690105017~01082014-006 and the SUV in photo 0690105017~06172014-002 are now located in the area marked Edwards Cemetery. The camper and mobile home in photo 0690105017~01082014-006 remain in the same location. According to satellite images, waste near the Edwards Cemetery area is identifiable in May 2011.

Monthly progress reports have been received for July 2014, August 2014, September 2014 and October 2014. Receipts enclosed with progress reports included:

 - c. 229 lbs Car Batteries at \$.20 = \$45.80
 - d. 9 lbs cast aluminum dirty at \$.30 = 2.70
 - i. Total Amount = \$284.10;
- 4. Fricker's Machine Shop & Salvage in the name of Angela Hollon for 51 lbs cans for \$30.60;
- 5. Atkinson Trash Service in the name of Jimmy Hollon for \$45 dated 9/11/2014;

The cleanup deadline for this site was October 31, 2014.

- 3. ~3 pickup trucks/SUVs X 18 CY = 54 CY
- 4. \sim 6 campers/boats X 25 CY = 150 CY
- 5. \sim 1 mobile home X 150 CY = 150 CY
- 6. ~2 piles of general construction demolition debris = 300+ CY
- 7. ~miscellaneous waste including appliances = 400+ CY
- 8. \sim 8 55-gallon drums full = 440 gallons X 7lbs/gallon = 3080 lbs or 1.54 tons




AC2 Site Map




