JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2014).

FACTS

1. That Gerald Cain is the current owner and Eddie Jones is the current operator ("Respondents") of a facility located at the following legal description: 89.92 Acres, Twp. 12S, RNG 2W, SEC 18, Part of SE SW SW NW NW SW, Union County, Illinois.

The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Ware/Cain-Jones.

- 2. That said facility is designated with Site Code No. 1818645005.
- 3. That Respondents have owned/operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on January 30, 2015, Sheila Williams of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of her inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Based upon direct observations made by Sheila Williams during the course of her January 30, 2015 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2014).
- (2) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3) (2014).
- (3) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general construction or demolition debris: or clean construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2014).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2014), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty

specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>April 10, 2015</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2014), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2014), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2014). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

NARRATIVE INSPECTION REPORT

A follow-up complaint investigation was conducted at the Cain property on January 30, 2015 by this author. Evidence of open dumping, open burning, litter, and the deposition of demolition debris were observed. It is recommended an Administrative Citation (AC) be sent to the property owner, Gerald Cain, and the apparent operator, Eddie Jones.

Several structures were present that are considered waste. The structures in photos 001, 003, 009, and 010 (left of picture) completely lacked parts of the walls which exposed the interiors. The protective underside of the mobile home in photo 005 had deteriorated to the point it was hanging down toward the ground. Photos 008 and 025 show exposed insulation on mobile homes. The mobile home on the right side of photo 010 had started to collapse.

The structure in photos 021 and 022, also showed disrepair such as a small area of exposed insulation and a missing window. However, compared to other structures, these repairs appeared to be minimal so this building will not be considered waste at this time. Appropriate repairs need to be made.

An apparent open burn pile was observed as seen in photo 006. It was apparent open burning had occurred due to the concentration of charred waste and ash toward the center of the pile and decreasing as the outer perimeter was approached.

A variety of waste was strewn throughout the site. It included, but was not limited to, demolition wood, a variety of metal, about 85 tires, a variety of plastics, concrete, insulation, broken glass, and general refuse. Larger concentrations of this can be seen in photos 007, 011 - 019, 024, and 026. A tire (photo 013) and part of a broom (007) were partially buried. The waste at the site did not appear to be in use, did not appear to be kept in a way to protect it for future use, and much of it did not appear to be useable in current conditions.

During the inspection, apparent violations of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (Act) and of the regulations, Title 35, Illinois Administrative Code, Subtitle G (35 I. A. C.) were observed.


Those apparent violations of the Act are Sections 9(a), 9(c), 21(a), 21(d)(1), 21(d)(2), 21(e), 21(p)(1), 21(p)(3), 21(p)(7), and 55(a)(1). The apparent violation of the regulations is Section 812.101(a). Additional information is provided in the Open Dump Inspection Checklist, attached.


The total amount of open dumped waste on-site is estimated at 1510 cubic yards.
