1 MS. GLOSSER: We will now allow  
2 members of the public to address the Board  
3 concerning items that appear on today's agenda.  
4 Is there anyone wishing to speak today?

5 MR. QUAIL: Yes.

6 MR. JOHNSON: There is.

7 MS. GLOSSER: If you can please come  
8 forward and state your name and who you represent  
9 for the record.

10 MS. TIPSORD: Mr. Quail, if you want  
11 to start.

12 MR. QUAIL: Right here is fine?

13 MS. TIPSORD: Yeah. Actually,  
14 Chairman Glosser, she can't see you unless you  
15 come into the -- if you want to sit down.

16 MR. QUAIL: For the audience or the  
17 camera?

18 MS. TIPSORD: So she can see you.  
19 She can see you now.

20 MR. QUAIL: Thank you, everyone, for  
21 the opportunity to make a comment today. My name  
22 is John Quail. I'm the Director of Watershed  
23 Policy for Friends of the Chicago River. So I'll  
24 be making a very quick comment on Docket Number

1 R08-9 Subdocket D. So I represent Friends of the  
2 Chicago River and our 4,000 members and supporters  
3 throughout the state. We're the only organization  
4 that is dedicated to advocating for the health and  
5 sustainability of the Chicago River system and our  
6 vision is to make the Chicago River one of the  
7 world's greatest metropolitan waterways.

8 We've been active in this  
9 process since the trial and review started in  
10 2002, certainly since the Board received the case  
11 in 2008. We support the Board's proposed rule on  
12 Subdocket D. The general use standard we feel is  
13 an adequate compromise that works to protect  
14 aquatic life in the Chicago River system or the  
15 CAWS as it's known here and in the rest of the  
16 state.

17 We really want to see this rule  
18 go into effect soon. The record has been built  
19 since 2008. There is no need to drag these  
20 proceedings on any longer in our opinion. Any  
21 polluters that are concerned with meeting these  
22 proposed standards have had an ample opportunity  
23 to demonstrate any hardships that would lead them  
24 to ask for additional variances.

1                   No attempt has been made to show  
2 these hardships in our opinion and we'd also like  
3 to offer our support as an organization to help  
4 the Board in any way that we can to ensure that  
5 this proposed rule is adopted as soon as possible.  
6 Thanks.

7                   MS. GLOSSER: Thank you, Mr. Quail.  
8 Is there anyone else that would like to offer a  
9 comment?

10                  MS. TIPSORD: And then we have  
11 Mr. Hirschfeld.

12                  MR. HIRSCHFELD: Hirschfeld.

13                  MS. GLOSSER: What was the last  
14 name?

15                  MR. HIRSCHFELD: Hirschfeld. Again,  
16 my name is Robert Hirschfeld. I'm with Prairie  
17 Rivers Network. We are a member supported water  
18 advocacy and river conservation group working in  
19 Illinois. I would like to reiterate many of  
20 John's comments. We support -- I'm commenting on  
21 Subdocket D. We support the Board's proposed rule  
22 on the general standards, temperature standards.  
23 We also would like to see the rule take effect  
24 soon. The record has been built solidly since

1 2008.

2 For any entities concerned with  
3 meeting standards, the proper venue to address  
4 that is a variance to show -- where they can show  
5 hardships. No -- no demonstration of a hardship  
6 has yet been shown in these proceedings.  
7 Similarly, we -- again, we support the rule and we  
8 offer our help in making sure that that rule is  
9 implemented timely. Thank you.

10 MS. GLOSSER: Thank you,  
11 Mr. Hirschfeld. Is there anyone else that would  
12 like to offer a comment?

13 MS. TIPSORD: Ms. Phillips.

14 MS. PHILLIPS: Hi. Good morning.  
15 Thank you for accepting our comments. My name is  
16 Katrina Phillips and I'm the clean water organizer  
17 from the Illinois chapter of The Sierra Club,  
18 which is a statewide organization representing  
19 over 24,000 members with over 7,000 members in the  
20 Chicago area.

21 So, thank you for accepting our  
22 comments on your first item on your agenda  
23 R08-9 D. The Sierra Club supports the Illinois  
24 Pollution Control Board's second notice rule and

1 believes that it should be adopted without delay  
2 in order to protect aquatic life in the Chicago  
3 Area Waterway System. An ample record has been  
4 built since the beginning of this process which we  
5 believe should allow the final steps to adopt the  
6 rule to move forward expediently now rather than  
7 allowing for more time-consuming proceedings to  
8 occur.

9           The Board's choice to propose  
10 the general use standards for temperature rather  
11 than duplicating work that has already been done  
12 elsewhere was an adequate compromise that works to  
13 protect aquatic life here as it does in the rest  
14 of the state and those concerned with the ability  
15 to meet the standards under the rule have the  
16 ability to seek variances if they are able to show  
17 hardship, yet none of them have made any attempt  
18 to demonstrate that hardship in these proceedings.

19           So we would also like to see the  
20 second notice rule go into effect as soon as  
21 possible and we understand you'll be accepting  
22 public comment and we'll be able to provide  
23 additional thoughts on the issues you're seeking  
24 public comment for as quickly as we can and we

1 would also like to offer assistance on anything  
2 that would help in this process. Thank you.

3 MS. GLOSSER: Thank you,  
4 Ms. Phillips. Is there anyone else that would  
5 like to offer comments today?

6 MR. JOHNSON: Not up here.

7 MS. GLOSSER: No one coming forward?

8 MS. TIPSORD: Uh-uh.

9 MS. GLOSSER: There is no one in the  
10 Springfield office. I want to thank everyone for  
11 participating today and offering comments as  
12 always will be helpful.

13 This concludes the time the  
14 Board has set aside to allow the public to address  
15 the Board. So, we will now proceed with the next  
16 item on our agenda.
