HEARING OFFOCER TIPSORD: Good afternoon. My name is Marie Tipsord, and I've been appointed by the Board to serve as Hearing Officer in this proceeding entitled "Amendments to Primary Drinking Water Standards, 35 Ill. Admin Code 611." The rulemaking is docketed as R15-23.

The purpose of today is twofold: First, the Board will hear testimony from any witnesses. The prefiling deadline for this hearing was August 12th, 2015, and the Board received no prefiled testimony.

For the record, is there anyone who wishes to testify today?

(No response.)

HEARING OFFOCER TIPSORD: For the record, no one is here at this time to give testimony.

The second purpose of today's hearing is to satisfy the requirement of Section 27B in the Environmental Protection Act. Section 27B of the act requires the Board to request the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity to conduct an economic impact study on certain proposed rules, prior to the adoption of those rules.

If DCEO chooses to conduct the economic impact study, DCEO has 45 days after such request to produce a study of economic impact of the proposed rules.

The Board must then make the economic impact study, or DCEO's explanation for not conducting the study, available to the public at least 20 days before a public hearing on the economic impact of the proposed rules.

In accordance with Section 27B of the act, the Board requested by a letter dated June 4th, 2015, and hand delivered on that day to DCEO, that DCEO conduct an economic impact study for the above-referenced rulemaking.

Any response from DCEO was due my July 16, 2015. We have received no response from DCEO. Does anyone wish to comment on DCEO's decision not to

Page 5 1 perform an economic impact study? 2 (No response.) 3 HEARING OFFOCER TIPSORD: Seeing none, I would 4 ask that we swear in the agency witness, or do you 5 want to make an opening statement and introduce 6 yourself? MR. GRADELESS: Sure. My named is Rex 8 Gradeless, Division of Legal Counsel of the Illinois 9 Environmental Protection Agency. 10 To my left is David McMillan, Manager of the Division of Public Water Supply at the Illinois 11 12 Environmental Protection Agency. 13 HEARING OFFOCER TIPSORD: Could we have 14 Mr. McMillan sworn in, please? 15 (Mr. McMillan was duly sworn.) 16 HEARING OFFOCER TIPSORD: I do have a followup 17 question for the agency. At the last hearing, 18 before the last hearing, we asked you about making 19 changes in Section 611-901, 611-904 and 611-908 in 2.0 an identical and substance rulemaking under Section 17.5 of the act. 2.1 22 Your response had indicated that it would 23 be prudent to make the changes in this rulemaking, 24 rather than an IIS rulemaking. The Board notes that

the agenda for tomorrow's board meeting includes a proposal for public comment in Section 17.5 IIS ruling.

In view of the opening of that rulemaking, and because those reference sections were not opened in the present rulemaking, does the agency have an opinion on how best to proceed with the correction?

MR. McMILLAN: I believe the Illinois EPA would not object to including this in an identical and substance rulemaking. Our only concern is that it is not, quote-unquote, identical to what the original proposal would have been.

So I don't know to what extent that would pose a problem to the Board. I'm not sure. I think it does reflect the intent of the original language that was in the original regulation.

HEARING OFFOCER TIPSORD: Thank you. Does anyone else have any questions for the agency witness?

(No response.)

HEARING OFFOCER TIPSORD: Seeing none, let's go off the record for about ten minutes to be sure that no one is late for anyone who wants to testify, and then we'll go back on the record.

Thank you. We're off the record.

HEARING OFFOCER TIPSORD: We'll go back on the record. While we were off the record earlier, I spoke with the agency, and I want to again ask, for the record, is anyone here to testify?
