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
RESPONSE TO RECOMMENDATION OF
ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

COMES NOW Saline County Landfill, Inc., and joins in the Recommendation of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, filed September 8, 2014, per 35 Illinois Administrative Code 104.416(d). Saline County Landfill, Inc., further responds:

1. Saline County Landfill, Inc., confirms paragraph 10, page 3-4, of the IEPA's Recommendation. Specifically, any adjusted standard request concerning total ammonia is not pursued at this time. The adjusted standard recommended by IEPA regards dissolved ammonia.

2. Any adjusted standard concerning specific conductance is not pursued at this time. Per paragraph 11, page 4, of the IEPA's Recommendation, Saline County Landfill will provide IEPA additional technical justification and graphic technical analysis for specific conductance. 35 Ill. Admin. Code 811.319 does not require statistical analysis of specific conductance monitoring data, so no adjusted standard is needed for this constituent.

Therefore, Saline County Landfill, Inc., joins the Recommendation filed by the IEPA September 8, 2015, in requesting the petition for adjusted standards be granted.

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
