JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 *et. seq.* (1996), specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

FACTS

- 1. Complainant, County of DuPage, is a unit of local government to which the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has delegated authority to issue administrative citations pursuant to Section 4(r) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, ("Act"), 415 ILCS 5/4(r) (2007). DuPage County is thus a "delegated unit" and may issue administrative citations under 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.200.
- 2. The Respondent, Thomas Schmerold, is the present owner and is in control of the property at 26W080 Roosevelt Road, Wheaton, located in the County of DuPage, State of Illinois.

- 3. The property is an open dump, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit, and designated with the Site Code #0438045020. The facility is known to the County as the Schmerold site.
- 4. The Respondents have occupied, controlled and/or operated the facility at all relevant times hereto.
- 5. On October 15, 2015, Andi Dierich, Field Inspector for DuPage County as delegated by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, inspected the property. A true and correct copy of the inspection report, along with Ms. Dierich's affidavit, are attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 6. Based upon direct observations made by Ms. Dierich during the course of her inspection, DuPage County has determined that Respondent violated the Act as follows:
 - a. Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, in violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1);
 - b. Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting the open burning of waste, in violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3).

Based upon the foregoing facts, under Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total civil penalty of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00).

Notices and Instructions to Respondent

- 1. You must pay the civil penalty set forth above unless you contest this Administrative Citation. The following paragraphs contain payment instructions and more information about contesting this Administrative Citation.
- 2. To pay the civil penalty (and any other amounts due) send two (2) checks or money orders with the attached Remittance Form, one check in the amount of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars payable to DuPage County and the second check or money order in the amount of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency to:

To ensure that you receive timely and proper credit for your payment, complete the attached Remittance Form and include it with your payment.

- 3. You may contest this Administrative Citation by filing a Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Appearance with the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board").
- 4. Any Petition for Review must be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation on you. The Board will not review the Administrative Citation if the Petition for Review is not filed within this time.
- 5. The Petition for Review must be filed with:

A copy of the Petition for Review must be served on the County of DuPage at the following address:

- 7. If you do not contest this Administrative Citation by filing a petition for review with the Board within the allotted time, the Board will enter an order finding that you committed the violations alleged above imposing the statutory civil penalty set forth above. See Section 31.1(d) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.500(a).
- 8. If you contest this Administrative Citation by filing a timely petition for review with the Board, the Board will hold a hearing. The Board's procedural rules have more information on hearings; see 35 Ill. Adm. Code Parts 101 and 108.
- 9. If the Board finds after the hearing that you committed a violation as alleged above, you will be assessed the hearing costs incurred by the County of DuPage and the Board. Hearing costs are assessed in addition to the statutory civil penalty for the violations. If the Board finds after the hearing that you did not commit a violation as alleged above, or that the violation resulted from uncontrollable circumstances, you will not be assessed hearing costs and you will not have to pay a civil penalty.
- 10. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time set by the Board in its final order, interest on the amount due will be assessed against you from the date payment is due and including the date that payment is received.
- 11. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time set by the Board in its final order, the Office of the Illinois Attorney General and/or the City of Chicago Department of Law may initiate court proceedings against you to collect the amount due, plus any interest accrued. In that event, you may also be liable for court costs.

Pre-Inspection Notes: On July 31, 2015 Joy Hinz and I inspected this property in response to a complaint. At the time there was evidence of open burning and dumping on site. An Administrative Citation Warning Notice was issued on August 3.

General Remarks

I conducted this inspection as a follow-up to the Administrative Citation Warning Notice issued on August 3, 2015. Deb Houdek, DuPage County Code Enforcement Officer, accompanied me on this inspection. After arriving, we walked to the house and proceeded to knock to announce our inspection. After waiting a few minutes with no response we walked to the north portion of the property.

A brick fire pit was situated directly behind the house on a patio located on the east side of the house. The pit contained the remains of and partially burned metal, metal cans, paper products, furniture and other miscellaneous municipal solid waste (Photo 1 and Photo 2). The pile was approximately 3.5 feet in diameter. North of the brick fire pit was a large 6-8 ft. circular patch of a burn pile. This larger burn pile contained partially burned paper, metal and other miscellaneous items.

Directly north and adjacent to the back of the house was a bin of municipal waste some bagged and some placed directly onto the patio. Scattered waste was present throughout the property. After noting burn piles and scattered material, Ms. Houdek issued a Violation Notice for DuPage County Code items. She attached the notice to the door and we then exited the property.

At that time, the site appeared to be in violation of 415 ILCS 21(p)(1) and 415 ILCS 21(p)(3). {End}
