ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. O’Leary):

On December 9, 2015, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Brickyard Disposal & Recycling, Inc. (petitioner) may appeal a November 25, 2015 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). The Agency determined that petitioner’s landfill expansion application was incomplete because it did not include a current Certification of Siting Approval form or a new or updated Groundwater Impact Assessment. Petitioner’s facility is located in Danville, Vermilion County.

The Board extends the appeal period until March 30, 2015, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
