**JURISDICTION**

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 *et. seq.* (2004), specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

**FACTS**

1. The Respondents, Wayne L. and Christina C. Fisher, are the present owners of a facility located in the County of Ogle, State of Illinois.
2. The facility, Located at 102 Oak Street, Holcomb, IL 61043, is an open dump, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit, and designated with the Site Code #1418215008. The facility is known to the Agency as Fisher, Wayne L. & Christina C.
3. That Respondents, Fisher, Wayne L. & Christina C., have controlled and/or operated the facility at all relevant times hereto.
4. That on March 9, 2016, Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department was notified of a complaint against this property from the Ogle County Planning and Zoning Department. The complaint stated that the above

mentioned property was being used to store waste, trailers, vehicles, and other rubbish.

5. That on March 11, 2016, Paul Cooney, Solid Waste Management Specialist and Michael Reibel, Planning and Zoning Administrator attempted to inspect the site. No one responded at the residence. Photographs were taken documenting open dumping and the property being used as a waste storage and disposal site.
6. This is the second Administrative Citation against the property owners for these violations, with the first Administrative Citation (AC-06-31) being issued in early 2006. In accordance with the Act (415 ILCS 5/42 (b)(4-5)), Administrative Citation fines are doubled for the second or subsequent violations.

#### **VIOLATIONS**

On the basis of Solid Waste Specialist, Paul Cooney, it was determined that the Respondents have caused or allowed open dumping and conducting a waste storage operation at the above described facility in a manner that has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "ACT") as follows:

1. The Respondent has caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner which resulted in litter at the site, in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1).
2. The Respondent has caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner which resulted in the deposition of general construction or demolition debris or clean construction or demolition debris in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7).

**CIVIL PENALTY**

In accordance with 415 ILCS 5/42 (b)(4), the Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of \$3,000.00 for each violation specified above. This is a total of \$6,000.00 for this Citation. Additionally, should the Respondent elect to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board under the review process described below, after an adjudicatory hearing, the Respondent shall be assessed the hearing costs incurred by the Pollution Control Board. The hearing cost would be in addition to the fine.

If you acknowledge the violations cited herein above, the civil penalty shall be due and payable no later than 35 days from the date of service hereof. If you do not petition the Pollution Control Board for review of the Administrative Citation within 35 days of service of the Administrative Citation, or contest the Citation, any judgment that may be rendered against you shall specify the due date of the civil fine and any additional costs assessed against you.

When payment is made, checks shall be made payable in equal amounts (\$3,000, or 50% of the total penalty each) to:

- (1) Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.
- (2) Ogle County Solid Waste Fund, Ogle County Treasurer, P.O. Box 40, Oregon, Illinois 61061.

If any civil penalty is not paid within the prescribed time, the law allows for the accumulation and payment of interest on the remaining unpaid balance. If any civil penalty is not paid when due, the Office of the State's Attorney shall be requested to initiate proceedings in

Circuit Court to collect the penalty. In addition to the civil penalty, hearing costs, and interest, if any, the Ogle County State's Attorney may seek to recover their costs of litigation.

**PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION**

You have the right to contest this Citation, pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/31.1. If you elect to contest this Citation, you must file a Petition For Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition For Review shall be filed with the Ogle County State's Attorney. **Your Petition For Review must be filed within 35 days of the date of service of the present citation on you. If you fail to file your Petition, a Default Order against you will entered by the Pollution Control Board.**


1. Affiant is a field inspector employed by the County of Ogle and has been so employed at all times pertinent hereto.

General Remarks

Mike Reibel, Director, Ogle County Planning and Zoning Department, and I arrived at the site at 2:14 p.m. This property was the subject of a complaint received by the Planning and Zoning Department on March 9, 2016. The complaint stated that the property has abandoned vehicles, trailers, appliances, tires, and other rubbish stored on-site.

This property has been the subject of an Administration Citation in 2006 from the Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department (OCSWMD) and an Administrative Citation Warning Notice in 2009. The property is known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) as Fisher, Wayne L. and Christina C. with Agency LPC#1418215008. The previous enforcement action taken by the OCSWMD was for waste being accumulated, stored, and burned on-site.

Violations included open dumping, open burning, deposition of general construction and demolition debris, litter, and not being permitted by the Agency to operate a waste storage/disposal site. The Fishers were conducting business cleaning out other properties in the Rockford and Chicago areas and storing or burning the waste at this property. The most recent inspection, prior to this inspection, was November 19, 2009 at which point the OCSWMD found the site to be in compliance.

Upon arrival, Mike Reibel and I approached the house and knocked on the door. There was no response after three attempts so we decided to make observations from the driveway and the railroad right of way.

We walked around the drive way and along the railroad tracks which are immediately to the east of the property. I could observe a large burn pile, roughly 9 feet in height, which included construction and demolition debris, including dimensional lumber, interior doors, and what appeared to be kitchen cabinetry. Accumulated all around the property was a great deal of material, including waste material, improperly stored tires, televisions sets, window-unit air conditioners and other appliances, construction and demolition debris, fencing, pipes, plastic and metal drums and other containers with unknown contents, several waste toters belonging to waste disposal companies (Advanced Disposal and Waste Management) on a trailer, vehicle components, a boat hull, which has been converted to a trailer for storage of waste, undetermined

household hazardous waste containers, several full garbage bags, landscape waste, furniture, bed frames, cabinets, electrical conduit, an old pickup truck which is being used for the storage of waste, and a vast amount of other debris and large amounts of scrap metal, most of which is exposed to the environment, with a small amount being partially covered by tarps.

Since the property owners were not present, I was unable to enter the property and complete a thorough inspection of the material being stored on this site, nor was I able to get measurements for an accurate estimation of waste stored on site, as I was limited to the drive way and rail road right-of-way. I did count at least 12 waste totes, 15 full garbage bags, 14 uncovered tires, 1 burn barrel, 3 barrels with unknown contents, 1 refrigerator, 5 window-unit air conditioners, 5 interior doors, a broken cathode ray tube television, an exterior door with shattered window, at least 2 old lawnmowers, 2 old bikes, and the large burn pile.

Mike Reibel also noted several Ogle County zoning violations, including vehicles stored on-site, the storage of material on-site, and using the property essentially as a junkyard.

We left the site at 2:25 p.m.

#### Alleged Violations

1. Pursuant to Section 21(a) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (Act), no person shall cause or allow the open dumping of any waste.

A violation of Section 21(a) of the [Illinois] Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21 (a)) is alleged for the following reason: Respondent has caused and/or allowed the open dumping and accumulation of waste on this property.

2. Pursuant to Section 21(d)(1) of the Act , in relevant part, no person shall conduct any waste storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation without a permit granted by the Agency or in violation of any conditions imposed by such permit, including periodic reports and full access to adequate records and the inspection of facilities, as may be necessary to assure compliance with this Act and with regulations and standards adopted thereunder.

A violation of Section 21(d)(1) of the [Illinois] Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(d)(1)) is alleged for the following reason: Respondent is conducting a waste storage operation on this property without an Agency permit.

3. Pursuant to Section 21(d)(2) of the Act, no person shall conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation in violation of any regulations or standards adopted by the Board under this Act.

A violation of Section 21(d)(2) of the [Illinois] Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(d)(2)) is alleged for the following reason: Respondent was conducting a waste storage and waste disposal operation in violation of the regulations and standards adopted by the Board.

4. Pursuant to Section 21(e) of the Act, no person shall dispose, treat, store or abandon any waste, or transport any waste into this State for disposal, treatment, storage or abandonment, except at a site or facility which meets the requirements of this Act and of regulations and standards thereunder.

A violation of Section 21(e) of the [Illinois] Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(e)) is alleged for the following reason: Respondent has used the property as an unpermitted waste storage site, and as such this site does not meet the standards set forth in the Act.

5. Pursuant to Section 21(p) of the [Illinois] Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)), no person shall, in violation of subdivision (a) of this Section[21], cause or allow the open dumping of any waste in a manner which results in:
  - (1) Litter;
  - (7) Deposition of: (i) general construction or demolition debris as defined in Section 3.160(a) of this Act

A violation of Section 21(p)(1) & (7) of the [Illinois] Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21 (p)(1) & (7)) is alleged for the following reasons: Respondent has caused and/or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner which resulted in the accumulation of litter, and the deposition of general construction and demolition debris upon this property in violation of 415 ILCS 5/3.160.

- 6) Pursuant to Section 55(a)(1) of the Act, no person shall cause or allow open dumping of any used or waste tire.

A violation of Section 55(a)(1) of the [Illinois] Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 55(a)(1)) is alleged for the following reason: Respondent has deposited multiple rimless tires at various locations on this property. These tires are exposed to the environment and not covered in any way.



YOU MUST COMPLETE THE  
FOLLOWING CORRECTIVE ACTIONS:

- #1 Immediately cease all open dumping. Do not dispose of any of the waste by open burning.
- #2 Immediately cease all transfer, storage and disposal of waste on site.
- #3 By May 16, 2016, remove all waste to a permitted landfill or transfer station. Scrap metal not disposed at a landfill can be taken to a scrap metal facility or recycling center.
- #4 By May 16, 2016, remove all white good (i.e.: appliances) to a facility that can legitimately accept them for recycling. White goods cannot be taken to a landfill or transfer station for the purpose of disposal.
- #5 By May 16, 2016, remove all landscape waste not generated on the premises to a permitted compost facility. Landscape waste cannot be taken to a landfill or transfer station for the purpose of disposal. Only landscape waste generated on the property may be burned as a method of disposal, and only under certain conditions.
- #6 By May 16, 2016, remove all used or waste tires to a registered tire storage or tire disposal facility. Used or waste tires cannot be taken to a landfill or transfer station for the purpose of disposal. Do not open burn any of the tires. Loads of more than 20 tires must hauled by

a registered tire transporter. Submit to the OCSWMD receipts from all tire disposal companies. Tires which are not waste must have rims properly attached or stored in a manner which prevents accumulation of water in the tires, with the amount limited to 12 tires stored on-site, pursuant to Sec.55.1 (a) (2) of the Act.


