Petitioner, Wabash Valley Power Association ("Petitioner" or "WVPA"), pursuant to 35 Ill. Admin. Code §101.500, hereby moves the Illinois Pollution Control Board (the "Board") to dismiss this action. In support of this motion, Petitioner states as follows:

- 1. On July 15, 2015, WVPA filed a Petition for Review of CAAPP Permit and Request for Partial Stay (the "Petition") requesting review of the Clean Air Act Permit Program ("CAAPP") permit issued to WVPA by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Agency") on June 12, 2015 (the "CAAPP Permit").
- 2. On July 23, 2015 and August 6, 2015, the Board entered orders accepting the Petition for hearing and granting WVPA's request for partial stay, respectively.
- 3. Subsequently, WVPA and the Agency have engaged in negotiations and resolved the issues raised in the Petition. Pursuant to the resolution, WVPA submitted an application to modify the CAAPP Permit and the Agency issued a revised permit to WVPA on June 3, 2016.
 - 4. WVPA requests that the Board dismiss this matter and close the docket.
 - 5. Counsel for the Agency does not object to this motion.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner, Wabash Valley Power Association, requests that the Board dismiss this action and close the docket.
