ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.K. Zalewski):

On August 23, 2016, Jackson County timely filed an administrative citation (AC) against Gary Clover alleging that on July 20, 2016, respondent violated Sections 21(p)(1), 21(p)(4), and 21(p)(7) of the Act, by causing or allowing the open dumping of waste resulting in litter, the deposition of waste in standing or flowing waters, and the deposition of general or clean construction or demolition debris. 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), (p)(4), (p)(7) (2014). The AC concerns Clover's facility located at 398 E. Industrial Park Rd in Murphysboro, Jackson County.

On January 4, 2017, Jackson County filed its Motion to Withdraw and Dismiss Administrative Citation (Motion). Jackson County states that it, "inspected the Respondent's site and found it to be cleaned up and in compliance with the open dumping laws." Motion at 1. The Board grants Jackson County's motion, dismisses the case, and closes the docket.
