

JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 *et. seq.*, specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

FACTS

1. The Respondent, Bruce Reese, is the present owner and in control and possession of a facility located in the County of Jackson, State of Illinois.
2. The Respondent, Bryan Bruce, is in control and possession and an occupant of a facility located in the County of Jackson, Illinois.
3. The facility is an open dump, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit, and designated with the Site Code # 077 801 5043. The facility is known to the Agency as the Carbondale/Bruce Reese site.
4. The Respondents have owned, occupied, controlled and/or operated the facility at all relevant times hereto.
5. On January 11, 2017, Don Terry, Field Inspector, Jackson County Health Department, inspected the facility. A true and correct copy of the inspection report, along with Mr. Terry's affidavit, are attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.

VIOLATIONS

On the basis of Field Inspector Don Terry's direct observation he has determined that the Respondents have caused or allowed open dumping at the above described facility in a manner that resulted in the following violations:

That on January 11, 2017, an inspection of the facility disclosed the following:

1. The Respondents have caused or allowed litter at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1).
2. The Respondents have caused or allowed the deposition of general or clean construction or demolition debris at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00). If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than March 15, 2017, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1, and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, checks shall be made payable in equal amounts (50% of total penalty each) to:

- (1) County of Jackson, c/o Jackson County Treasurer, Jackson County Courthouse, Murphysboro, Illinois 62966; and
- (2) Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.

Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Forms with payments to ensure proper documentation of payment. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Complainant may either initiate proceedings against either or both Respondents in Circuit Court or other debt collection actions to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

You have the right to contest this Citation, pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/31.1. If you elect to contest this Citation, you must file a Petition For Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition For Review shall also be filed with Daniel Brenner, Assistant State's Attorney, Jackson County Courthouse, Third Floor, Murphysboro, Il 62966. **YOUR PETITION FOR REVIEW MUST BE FILED WITHIN 35 DAYS OF THE DATE OF SERVICE OF THE PRESENT CITATION ON YOU. YOUR PETITION MUST STATE THE REASON(S) YOU BELIEVE THE PRESENT MATTER SHOULD NOT BE ISSUED. IF YOU FAIL TO FILE YOUR PETITION AND STATE THE REASONS THE PRESENT MATTER SHOULD NOT BE ISSUED, A DEFAULT ORDER AGAINST YOU WILL BE ENTERED BY THE POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD.**

GENERAL REMARKS

During the stated date and time, I conducted an inspection of the site listed above. This inspection was made as a follow up to: 1) two previous inspections of the site that resulted in violation warning notices being sent to the owner and operator and 2) a recent complaint (**2017-010**) received by the Jackson County Health Department. At the time of the inspection, the site owner was listed as Bruce Reese by the Jackson County Assessor's Office [**Attachment: Page 1**]. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were: Light rain with moderate winds and a temperature of approximately 66°F. I was accompanied on this inspection by Kyle Scerena of the Jackson County Health Department (JCHD).

I was driving east along Dillinger Road, a public roadway. As I approached the site I observed what appeared to be open dumped waste scattered about the site. I parked my vehicle at the east end of the site and observed from a location on the public right-of-way, an area of open dumped waste (**Photo #1, Site Sketch-Area A**). The waste in this area consisted of but was not limited to: dimensional lumber, plastic containers (excluding the trash cans in the foreground), a waste boat trailer, a waste riding lawnmower, two waste vehicles and two used/waste tires.

I walked west along the driveway towards the residence to determine if someone was at home. Along the way, I observed more open dumped waste (**Photos #2 - #4, Site Sketch-Area B**). The waste in this area consisted of but was not limited to: a pile of plastic bags filled with aluminum cans approximately 4 feet high, a metal highway sign, plastic containers, house fans, plastic children's toys, scrap metal, indoor lamps, plywood, wooden furniture, dimensional lumber, a metal realtor's sign and filled plastic bags.

As I approached the residence an individual came out onto the porch. I asked if he was Bryan Bruce and he said yes and added that he did not like me taking photos of his house. I asked if he wanted me to leave the site, and he said yes. I explained that I would finish taking my photos from the road.

I left the site and observed from Dillinger Road, two more areas of open dumped waste (**Site Sketch: Areas C & D**). The waste in these two areas consisted of but were not limited to: scrap metal, dimensional lumber and plastic items (**Photo #5, Site Sketch-Area C**) and a wheel chair, dimensional lumber, a mattress, plastic containers and a wooden table (**Photo #6, Site Sketch-Area D**).

At the time of the inspection, the items listed as waste in the narrative were not in use, were not useable in their current condition, and were not stored in such a way as to protect any future use. Also at the time of the inspection, the items were unorganized and stored in an unsightly manner.

The total volume of waste observed was approximately 200 cubic yards.

My inspection ended at approximately 2:33 p.m.

Violations Observed:

Item #5(21)(a): Cause or allow open dumping; Item #8(21)(p)(1 and 7): Cause or allow the open dumping of any waste in a manner which results in any of the following occurrences at the dump site: (1) Litter and (7) Deposition of general construction or demolition debris; or clean construction or demolition debris: At the time of the inspection, the open dumping of waste that caused or allowed litter and the deposition of general construction or demolition debris was observed.

Item #9(55)(a)(1): No person shall: Cause or allow open dumping of any used or waste tire: At the time of the inspection two used/waste tires that had been open dumped were observed.


