ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.M. Santos):

On April 23, 2009, Ameren Energy Generating Company and Venice Power Plant asked the Board to review a March 19, 2009 Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) renewal permit determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). On July 23, 2009, the Board stayed the effectiveness of the contested conditions pending the final resolution of the appeal. The parties have reached an agreement about the issues in the appeal, and petitioners received a final modified CAAPP permit addressing the issues raised in the appeal on December 28, 2016. On January 31, 2017, petitioners filed an unopposed motion to voluntarily dismiss the permit appeal. The Board grants the motion, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
