JOINT REQUEST FOR NINETY DAY EXTENSION OF APPEAL PERIOD

Dear Sir or Madam:

In connection with the Application for Construction Permit, with supporting documentation, submitted by your engineers, Heneghan and Associates, P.C., for the construction of a ground storage tank, this is to advise that under the Environmental Protection Act (Act) this Agency must issue or deny approval for projects within 90 days of their submission. Section 39a of the Act requires the Agency to issue permits or cite the reasons for denial within that time period.

- The Agency shall not grant any construction permit required by this Part unless the applicant submits adequate proof that the proposed improvements conform to the design criteria cited in 35 lll. Adm. Code Part 602.105(a)(2). Construction of the proposed improvements must be in accordance with the American Water Works Association Standards. Furthermore, the American Water Works Association (AWWA) has indicated that AWWA D103 does not apply to stainless steel tanks. Therefore, the Agency must deny this Application for Construction Permit.
- 2. The applicant failed to demonstrate that the insect screen in the overflow is 24 mesh in accordance with Section 7.0.7(b) of the Recommended Standards for Water Works.
