CASE

The Attorney General has brought a case against Illinois Fuel Company, LLC, a Kentucky limited liability company and Cheyenne Resources, Inc. a Kentucky corporation (Cheyenne Resources), for violating State pollution control rules. On December 22, 2017, the parties filed a stipulation and proposal for settlement. The parties agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and in accordance with State law, have requested that the settlement be adopted without holding a public hearing as to Cheyenne Resources only. Any person who would like to comment on, or demand a public hearing on, the stipulation and proposal for settlement may do so by filing a written comment or hearing demand with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 30 days after the publication of this notice. The written comment or hearing demand must refer to People of the State of Illinois v. Illinois Fuel Company, LLC, a Kentucky limited liability company and Cheyenne Resources, Inc. a Kentucky corporation, PCB 10-86, and must be filed with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, 100 West Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601.
