The Board also affirmed the hearing officer’s rulings to admit into evidence Exhibits 5.5, 6, 7, 16, 204G–209G, 210H–215H, 222J–228J, and 236L–241L. The Board overturned the hearing officer’s ruling to admit Exhibit 261 into evidence, and instead excluded it.</p>	<p>4-0 Carter abstained</p>
<p>PCB 15-58</p>	<p><u>Cedar Concepts Corporation v. IEPA</u> (Air – Permit Appeal) – The Board granted petitioner’s motion for voluntary dismissal of this permit appeal.</p>	<p>5-0</p>
<p>PCB 18-43</p>	<p><u>People of the State of Illinois v. Scott Dean d/b/a Scott Dean Swine Farm and Hollis Shafer d/b/d Hollis Shafer Swine Farm</u> (Air, Water – Enforcement) – In this air and water enforcement action concerning a Fulton County facility, the Board granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1) (2016)), accepted a stipulation and settlement agreement, and ordered respondents to pay a total civil penalty of \$15,000 and to cease and desist from further violations.</p>	<p>3-0 Carter and Santos abstained</p>
<p>PCB 18-47</p>	<p><u>People of the State of Illinois v. Bodycote Thermal Processing, Inc., a Delaware corporation</u> (Air – Enforcement) – In this air enforcement action concerning a Cook County facility, the Board granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1) (2016)), accepted a stipulation and settlement agreement, and ordered respondent to pay a \$10,000 civil penalty and to cease and desist from further violations.</p>	<p>5-0</p>
