MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION

NOW COMES the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency or Illinois EPA), by and through one of its attorneys, Sara G. Terranova, hereby submits its Motion for Clarification with respect proposed Section 104.525(b)(3). In support thereof, the Illinois EPA states at follows:

- 1. On February 8, 2018, the Illinois Pollution Control Board (Board) proceeded to second notice review in the above captioned matter.
- 2. The Board accepted the Agency's proposed rules with a few modifications. *See* R18-18 Opinion and Order of the Board: Proposed Rule; Second Notice (February 8, 2018) at 19.
- 3. Specifically, the Board accepted the Agency's modification to the Section 104.525(b)(3) as proposed in Public Comment 18 at 12. *See Id.* at 5. However, the Agency's proposed modification is not reflected in the Board's Addendum to the Board's Order of February 8, 2018.
 - 4. The Agency proposed the following modification to Section 104.525(b)(3):

 "if the person fails to file an amended petition to address the Board's nonsubstantial compliance determination under Section 104.545 by the

 deadline established under Section 104.540, the Board will dismiss the

 original petition and the stay continues all rights to judicial review are

exhausted."

5. It is unclear to the Agency if the Board intends to proceed with the Agency's proposed modification to Section 104.525(b)(3) or if the Board intends to proceed with the language as provided in the Board's Addendum to the Board Order of February 8, 2018.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA respectfully requests the Board provide clarification if the Board intends to proceed with the Agency's proposed modification to Section 104.525(b)(3) or if the Board intends to proceed with the language as provided in the Board's Addendum to the Board Order of February 8, 2018.
