**HEARING OFFICER ORDER**


On March 29, 2018, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. The complainant has forwarded some additional information to the respondent including two estimates for plumbing work to resolve any backflow issue at the site. The complainant is currently seeking a third estimate and will be forwarded to the respondent.

By agreement, complainant is to file her response to respondent's motion to dismiss for want of prosecution is now due on May 17, 2018.

Any deadlines for answering the request to admit or responding to the outstanding motions, including responding to respondent's motions for clarification and reconsideration filed August 24 and 25, 2016, are stayed.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on May 10, 2018, at 10:30 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.
