**ORDINANCE NO. 18-6 ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS OF HOMEWOOD PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2018 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2019** WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Homewood Public Library District, Cook County, Illinois caused to be prepared in tentative form a Budget and the Secretary of the Board has made the same conveniently available to public inspection for at least thirty (30) days prior to action thereon, and WHEREAS, a public hearing was held as to such Budget on September 19, 2018 and notice of said hearing was given at least thirty (30) days prior thereto as required by law, and all legal requirements have been complied with. NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Homewood Public Library District, Cook County, Illinois, as follows: Section 1: That the fiscal year of the Homewood Public Library District is hereby fixed to begin July 1, 2018, and end on June 30, 2019. Section 2: That the following Budget containing an estimate of the amount available and expenditures and the appropriations therein be and the same is hereby adopted as the budget and appropriations for this Public Library District for this fiscal year and the sum of \$3,202,271 or as much thereof as may be authorized by law, is hereby appropriated for the purpose of the Homewood Public Library District, as herein after specified for said fiscal year.
