ORDER OF THE BOARD (by K. Papadimitriou):

On January 15, 2019, Tri-County Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Tri-County) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal (Mot.), which concerns a leaking underground storage tank (UST) site located at 3906 W. Broadway, Mt. Vernon, Jefferson County. Tri-County appeals Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's (Agency) October 19, 2016 determination, approving the Site Investigation Completion Report and modifying the actual costs budget. The motion notes that Tri-County no longer seeks to appeal the Agency's determination because of the Board's ruling in Benton Fire Department v. IEPA, PCB 2017-001. Mot. at 1. The Board received no objections to the motion. The Board grants Tri-County's motion, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
