ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B.K. Carter):

On November 7, 2018, Susanne M. Kirkham and Steven C. Kirkham (Kirkhams) filed a *pro se* citizens enforcement complaint against the Village of Poplar Grove (Village). The Kirkhams' complaint concerned the Village's sanitary sewer system in Boone County. The complaint alleges the Village violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) water pollution regulations, resulting in the overflow of raw sewage in the Kirkhams' residential basement.

On February 28, 2019, the Board dismissed the complaint as frivolous for failure to state a claim. Kirkham v. Village of Poplar Grove, Illinois, PCB 19-70, slip op. at 3 (Feb. 28, 2019). The Board, however, allowed the Kirkhams until March 29, 2019, to amend their complaint. *Id.* The Board also cautioned the Kirkhams that failing to file an amended complaint by March 29, 2019, "will result in the Board dismissing this case and closing the docket." *Id.* No amended complaint was filed by that date. The Board therefore dismisses the case and closes the docket.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

Section 41(a) of the Environmental Protection Act provides that final Board orders may be appealed directly to the Illinois Appellate Court within 35 days after the Board serves the order. 415 ILCS 5/41(a) (2016); see also 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(d)(2), 101.906, 102.706. Illinois Supreme Court Rule 335 establishes filing requirements that apply when the Illinois Appellate Court, by statute, directly reviews administrative orders. 172 Ill. 2d R. 335. The Board's procedural rules provide that motions for the Board to reconsider or modify its final orders may be filed with the Board within 35 days after the order is received. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.520; see also 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.902, 102.700, 102.702. Filing a motion asking that the Board reconsider this final order is not a prerequisite to appealing the order. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.902.
