ORDER OF THE BOARD (by A. Palivos):

On May 6, 2019, petitioner Citizens Against Ruining the Environment (CARE) and respondents Jackson Generating, LLC (Jackson Generating) and Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) filed a joint motion to voluntarily dismiss (Mot.) this third-party National Pollutant Discharge Eliminating System (NPDES) permit appeal. CARE's third-party appeal concerns the NPDES permit that the Agency issued to Jackson Generating for the Jackson Energy Center located at the intersection of Brandon and Noel Roads in Elwood, Will County. The joint motion explains that the parties have reached a settlement that renders the appeal moot. The Board grants the motion, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
