PRE-FILED QUESTIONS BY OPENLANDS AND SIERRA CLUB, ILLINOIS CHAPTER FOR JAMES E. HUFF AND ROGER KLOCEK

- 1. Please comment upon whether the water quality standard at lower temperatures will be protective of sensitive mussel glochidia, such as the fat mucket (*Lampsilis siliquoidea*), wavy rayed lampmussel (*Lampsilis fasciola*), northern riffleshell (*Epioblasma torulosa rangiana*), and plain pocketbook (*Lampsilis cardium*), given that a temperature relationship regarding chloride toxicity has not been determined for glochidia.
- Please comment on whether the water quality standard at lower temperatures will be protective of *S. simile* given that Dr. Soucek's tests did not show a temperature difference for chronic toxicity for this species at 10 degrees Celsius compared to 25 degrees Celsius. (See Pre-filed testimony of David J. Soucek, Ph.D., 12/21/2018, Table 19, page 4.)
- 3. In reference to the Illinois Pollution Control Board's questions for Huff & Huff's amended proposal, please note that in question 2 part b, the second sentence, "For *Lampsilis silioquoidea* juveniles, 24-hour EC50 values were reported as low as 911 mg/L Cl at 43 mg/L hardness" should read "at 50 mg/L hardness."
- 4. In reference to the Illinois Pollution Control Board's questions for Huff & Huff's amended proposal, question 2 part b on page 6, please comment on why 96 hour EC50 tests are preferred for developing water quality criteria? Are 24 hour tests likely to underestimate effects?
