ORDER OF THE BOARD (by K. Papadimitriu):

On June 17, 2019, Congress Development Company (Congress) filed a motion (Mot.) to voluntarily dismiss this consolidated appeal, which concerns Congress' landfill facility located at 4100 West Frontage Road in Hillside, Cook County. Congress filed four separate petitions appealing permit determinations by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA). The Board consolidated the first two appeals on July 21, 2011, and on November 17, 2011, consolidated all four of them for hearing although not necessarily for decision.

Congress' motion states that on June 13, 2019, IEPA issued a modified permit "that resolves the issues that gave rise to these appeals." Mot. at 1. The motion further states that "there is no longer any dispute ripe for resolution by the Board at this time." *Id.* at 3. Congress adds that the respondent does not object to dismissal. *Id.*

The Board grants Congress' motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the consolidated appeal, and closes the docket.
