## **HEARING OFFICER ORDER**

The parties have submitted their respective proposed discovery schedules. Initial written interrogatories and document requests must be issued on or before January 10, 2020;

Responses to initial written interrogatories and document requests must be served on or before March 20, 2020;

Close of fact discovery, including depositions of lay or fact witnesses must be completed on or before July 17, 2020.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on December 4, 2019, at 11:30 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance.
