

**AGREED MOTION TO

NOW COMES the Respondent, Pamarco, Inc., by and through its undersigned attorneys, and respectfully requests that the Board enter an order enlarging the time by which Respondent is to file its answer in the above-captioned matter by 60 days. In support of this Agreed Motion, Respondent states as follows:

1. On May 29, 1996, the plaintiff, the People of the State of Illinois, by its attorney, Attorney General James Ryan (the "State"), filed its complaint in the above-captioned cause. Service was made by certified mail upon Respondent's attorney and the complaint was received on May 31, 1996. Pursuant to the Board's Rules, the Respondent's answer is due to be filed on July 1, 1996.

2. On May 22, 1996, the parties met to discuss the matters alleged in the complaint and to explore the possibility of settling the claims advanced by the State. The parties have agreed to continue settlement discussions.


3. This motion is not made to delay but rather to explore fully the possibility of settlement and to avoid the unneeded burden and expense of litigating this matter if settlement is indeed achievable.

4. The undersigned has discussed the substance of this motion and shown a copy of it to counsel for the petitioner who has agreed that the relief sought herein is appropriate.

WHEREFORE, Respondent Pamarco respectfully requests that the Board enter an order enlarging the time by which Respondent is to file its answer by 60 days, to and including August 30, 1996.


