NOW COMES the Respondent, Pamarco, Inc., by and through its undersigned attorneys, and respectfully requests that the Board enter an order enlarging the time by which Respondent is to file its answer in the above-captioned matter by 30 days. In support of this Agreed Motion, Respondent states as follows:


1. On May 29, 1996, the plaintiff, the People of the State of Illinois, by its attorney, Attorney General James Ryan (the "State"), filed its complaint in the above-captioned cause. Service was made by certified mail upon Respondent's attorney and the complaint was received on May 31, 1996. Pursuant to the Board's Rules, the Respondent's answer originally was due to be filed on July 1, 1996. On June 24, 1996, the parties filed an Agreed Motion to Enlarge Time to File Answer, which motion was granted by the Board.

2. Settlement discussions have been ongoing during the past 60 days. The parties and their counsel believe a short extension of an additional 30 days will allow them to exhaust fully the possibility of settlement and avoid the unneeded burden and expense of litigating this matter.

3. The undersigned has discussed the substance of this motion and shown a copy of it to counsel for the petitioner who has agreed that the relief sought herein is appropriate.

WHEREFORE, Respondent Pamarco respectfully requests that the Board enter an order enlarging the time by which Respondent is to file its answer by an additional 30 days, to and including September 30, 1996.


