
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.M. Santos):

On May 13, 2020, the Illinois State Toll Highway Authority (Authority) filed a motion to dismiss this appeal (Mot.), which concerns a leaking underground storage tank (UST) site located at eastbound Interstate Highway 294 in South Holland, Cook County. The Authority had filed a petition for review of a determination by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency modifying the high priority corrective action plan for the site.

The motion reports that the parties have settled all disputes and that no issue remains to be resolved. Mot. at 1. The Board grants the Authority's motion, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
