HEARING OFFICER ORDER


On June 11, 2020, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference. The parties reported that discovery is proceeding but due to the COVID-19 pandemic, logistical issues are arising, especially with depositions. The parties will submit a revised discovery schedule within the next 10 days but the parties were advised that it may need to be revisited when the proposed time-line for discovery expires.

The parties also indicated that there may be some discovery disagreements that may necessitate motion practice. The parties were advised to double their efforts in resolving any discovery issues before filing any motions.

On February 13, 2020, the parties filed an “Agreed Motion for Entry of Discovery Agreements.” The motion is granted.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on July 30, 2020, at 11:30 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.


