
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.M. Santos):

On June 5, 2020, AmerenEnergy Resources Generating Company, Duck Creek Power Station (Ameren) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit appeal. The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency issued a CAAPP permit with conditions for Ameren’s coal-fired power plant at 1775 North CILCO Road in Canton, Fulton County. Ameren challenged numerous conditions and the effective date of the permit.

Ameren reports that counsel for the respondent does not object to the motion to dismiss. The Board grants Ameren’s motion to dismiss, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
