HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: My
name is Mike McCambridge. This is a public
hearing being held to satisfy USEPA SIP
Requirements, State Implementation Plan requirements, procedurally that require that we notice for a hearing, and if anyone has interest about the hearing, we are just conducting the hearing.

This is the R19-15 Definition of VOM Update. The Board proposed amendments on May 21st. The public -- or the notice of proposed amendments appeared in the June 5th, 2020 issue of the Illinois Register. Start -- that started the public comment period, which would conclude 45 days later on July 20th, 2020.

However, to offer opportunity
for persons to respond to anything in this hearing, I am keeping it open for -- the record open for an additional 15 days until July 31st, 2020, to basically take advantage of any additional comments.

The next scheduled Board
meeting, which is our target for adoption of this, is August 13, 2020. We've already identified

everybody for the record. Attending Board -Board Members are Chairman Currie and Member Carter.

The Update R19-15 applies to the second half of 2018. On November 28th, 2018, USEPA added another chemical, a hydrofluoroolefin, to the list of chemicals exempt from the definition of volatile organic material, or VOM. I will spare reading the chemical name. The Board's opinion gives that. It also gives the HFO number and CAS -- CAS number.

So far during the public comment period we received a comment from JCAR requesting a very minor correction in capitalization to the chemical name, and that's something that will be included or addressed in the Board's adopting opinion and order.

We also received comments from the Illinois EPA. Illinois EPA requested that we list the chemicals -- or the Board list the chemicals exactly as they appear in 40 CFR Section 51. 100 (s), which is the federal definition that underlies our action.

The Board has acquired the
practice of identifying chemicals by their IUPAC names. IUPAC is the International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry. Many chemicals have a multitude of names. The IUPAC people have come to identifying chemicals by a specific naming scheme. There are multiple IUPAC names, even for many chemicals, but they are standardized.

And then, of course, CAS
numbers, Chemical Abstract Service numbers, a number is assigned to a chemical by the CAS people. They are very specific, in that if you have isomers or mixtures of chemicals, they will bear different CAS numbers.

USEPA has formed the habit -since the Board started identifying things by CAS number, USEPA has also acquired the habit of identifying chemicals in their Federal Register notices; however, that is not how they are identified in 40 CFR Section 51.100(s). The USEPA uses a lot of common names.

The Board will address the Agency comment. It's not for me to do, but \(I\) only recommend to the Board what I see. But the Board will address that when adopting the amendments.
