## ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD August 27, 2020

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Adopted Rule. Final Order.

OPINION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. F. Currie):

Today the Board adopts final amendments to the cross connection control device inspectors (CCCDI) license renewal period. These amendments extend the renewal period for CCCDIs due to COVID-19, in order to prevent job-loss and to ensure CCCDIs remain licensed so they can monitor Illinois' public water distribution systems.

The final amendments to Part 604 are unchanged from the amendments that the Board proposed earlier in this rulemaking. Accordingly, the Board does not repeat here its detailed discussions of the rule changes found in its first- and second-notice opinions. *See* Proposed Amendments to Manifesting Requirements: Special (35 Ill. Adm. Code 809), R20-21 (May 21, 2020 (First-Notice Op.); July 27, 2020 (Second-Notice Op.)).

In this opinion, the Board provides the procedural history of the rulemaking, followed by the Board's order directing the Clerk to file the amendments with the Secretary of State. The amendments themselves, which will take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State (*see* 5 ILCS 100/5-40(d) (2018)), appear at the end of this opinion and order.

#### PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On April 16, 2020, the Board adopted an emergency rule proposed by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) extending the licensure period for CCCDIs, with an effective date of April 17, 2020. *In re* R20-20, April 16, 2020; 44 Ill. Reg. 7777 (May 1, 2020). This proposal replaces the emergency rule which expires on September 13, 2020.

On May 5, 2020, the Board requested that the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) perform an economic impact study of the Board's proposal. *See* 415 ILCS 5/27(b) (2018). The Board did not receive a response to its request.

On May 21, 2020, the Board adopted a first notice opinion and order amending the renewal period for CCCDI licensure due to COVID-19. *See* 44 Ill. Reg. 9352 (June 5, 2020) (Part 604).

On May 27, 2020, the hearing officer issued an order scheduling two hearings, each to be held via video conference between the Board's Chicago office and Springfield office, as well as by Webex due to COVID-19. The first hearing was scheduled on June 18, 2020, and the second on July 13, 2020.

On July 27, 2020, the Board proposed the amendments for second-notice review by the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules (JCAR). At its August 11, 2020 meeting, JCAR issued a "Certification of No Objection" to the proposed amendments, subject to a handful of non-substantive changes which the Board includes in the final rules.

### <u>ORDER</u>

The Board directs the Clerk to submit the final amendments to the Secretary of State for publication in the *Illinois Register* and codification in the Illinois Administrative Code. The amendments appear following this opinion and order. All additions are underlined; all deletions appear with strikethroughs.

### **Section 604.1520 COVID-19 Emergency Provisions**

Due to the public health emergency related to the COVID-19 outbreak, the CCCDI approval renewal application deadlines for 2020 pursuant to Section 604.1510(b)(2) are extended. For renewal year 2020, CCCDIs must-renew their CCCDI Approval between August 31 and October 30. An application for CCCDI renewal will be sent by the Agency or its designee and must be completed and returned by October 30, 2020.
