MS. TIPSORD: Good afternoon. My name is
Marie Tipsord. I'm General Counsel with the Illinois Pollution Control Board, and I'm going to call this hearing to order. I'm physically here in Springfield calling the hearing to order.

And with that, I will turn it over to the hearing officer, Mark Kaminski.

HEARING OFFICER KAMINSKI: Thank you, Marie.
Good afternoon and welcome to the Illinois Pollution Control Board hearing. My name is Mark Kaminski, and I'm the hearing officer for this Rulemaking proceeding entitled, "Rulemaking for Proposed New 35 Illinois Administrative Code 249 Ethylene Oxide Ambient Air Monitoring." The Board Docket Number for this Rulemaking is R20-18.

Also present today for the Board are Board Member Santos.

And I'm not sure -- before I go any further, "Call-in User 4," might you identify yourself?

MS. SANTOS: That's me, Cynthia. I think I'm 4. No, I'm 5. Sorry.

HEARING OFFICER KAMINSKI: I think you're 3.
There's 4. You're currently unmuted if you want to respond? Okay. Nothing else there.

[^0]Board staff present are the Chicago office, myself, Mark Kaminski, and Tim Fox. In the Springfield office, Marie Tipsord. On Webex we have Vanessa Horton, and I believe that's it for the moment.

Please, will the members of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency identify themselves?

MS. PALUMBO: My name is Antonette Palumbo. I'm an attorney in the Air Regulatory Unit, and I represent the Agency in this matter.

We have three other individuals with the Agency on this, and I will allow them to introduce themselves now.

MR. BLOOMBERG: I am David Bloomberg. I'm the manager of the Air Quality Planning section.

I have two of my staff here who can go ahead and introduce themselves.

MR. DAVIS: I'm Rory Davis, the manager of the Regulatory Development Unit with the Bureau of Air.

MS. PALUMBO: Go ahead, David.
MR. BLOOMBERG: We also have Ranganath Gurram. He works in the Regulatory Development Unit. He is here as an observer as well.

[^1]MR. GURRAM: Thank you. Hello. This is Ranganath Gurram. I'm with the Bureau of Air in the Regulatory Development Unit.

MR. BROWN: Hi. This is Don Brown. Our chairman also just joined in, Barbara Flynn Curie.

HEARING OFFICER KAMINSKI: Thank you.
And with that, we will move forward with the hearing. This hearing is governed by the Board's procedural rules. All information that is relevant and that is not repetitious or privileged will be admitted into the record.

Please bear in mind that any questions that are posed by the Board and staff are solely to help develop a clear and complete record for the Board's decision and do not reflect any decision on the proposal testimony or other questions.

Due to COVID-19, in addition to the videoconferencing, we're also allowing Webex participation via computer and phone. As a reminder, the prefiled testimony is available as well as the transcripts are available on the clerk's office online or COOL through the Board's website. Simply search for Docket Number R 28-18 -- I'm sorry -- 20-18.

For the sake of our court reporter, please
speak clearly and avoid speaking at the same time as another person so that we can help produce a clear transcript.

For those participating by Webex, either on the phone or using the call-in feature for sound, if you want to speak during the hearing, please take your phone off speakerphone and talk into the phone normally, as this will produce a much clearer sound.

If you wish to speak, you will also have to unmute yourself. All individuals entering the Webex feed are muted on entry. For those on a commuter, you can click the microphone symbol to unmute yourself. For those participating in as call-in users, you must press star 6 on your keypad to unmute yourself.

I'd also like to note that there may be a slight delay in the Webex video, so be mindful of that when communicating with each other.

Also, as a result of using Webex, we are video-recording today's hearing to ensure our court reporter is able to get an accurate transcript. Once the Board receives the transcript, the recording will be destroyed.

Note that due to issues related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the first hearing and the second
hearing in this docket were originally cancelled. The first hearing was then held on June 25 th of this year.

On February 27, 2020, the Board received prefiled testimony on behalf of the Agency by David Bloomberg, for other participants' prefiled testimony.

At the first hearing on June 25, 2020, the Agency's prefiled testimony was entered in the record as read pursuant to Section 104.424(f) of the Board's procedural rules.

The Board heard testimony from Agency witness David Bloomberg and was questioned by the Board, and Agency witness Rory Davis was made available for questions. The transcript of that hearing is available in the COOL system.

Notice for this second hearing was posted on July 28, 2020. The Board published notice of the second hearing in several newspapers: On July 30th of this year, the Belleview-News Democrat and the Chicago Sun-Times; on July 31st, the Rockford Registry Star, Springfield Journal Register, Peoria Journal Star, Centralia and Mount Vernon Morning Sentinels; on the 1st of August, the LaSalle News Tribune and the Dispatch/Rock Island Argus. On the 2nd of August,

[^2]Champaign News Gazette; and on the 5th of August, the Galena Gazette.

On July 28, 2020, the Hearing Officer directed that any additional prefiled testimony was to have been filed with the Board by August 20 th of this year. Any prefiled questions based upon that testimony was to have been filed by August 27th. No additional prefiled testimony or prefiled answers were received.

For the record, is there anyone present here today in person or via Webex who did not prefile testimony for the second hearing who wishes to offer testimony?

Hearing none, I'll move on to comments.
Is there anyone present here today in person or via Webex who wishes to offer public comment at this second hearing?

Remember, call-in users, you must press star 6 on your keypad to unmute yourself.

Hearing none, at this point we will go off the record and discuss next procedural steps.
