

BOARD MEETING MINUTES

September 17, 2020

11:00 a.m.

Teleconference

Consistent with the Governor's Disaster Proclamation of August 21, 2020, issued in response to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic, as well as Public Act 101-0640, effective June 12, 2020, the Board conducted this regular open meeting by teleconference.

The agenda provided dial-in information for members of the public and explained how they could use their telephones to participate in the meeting—whether by listening, speaking during Public Remarks, or both. Further, the agenda stated that the operator would ask for the name of each member of the public calling in and explain what to do for those who wished to speak. PCB 20-98	People of the State of Illinois v. Aux Sable Liquid Products, Inc., Aux Sable Liquid Products LP, Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc., and Waste Management of Illinois, Inc. (Land, RCRA – Enforcement) – The Board issued two orders in this enforcement action involving sites located in Grundy and Will Counties. First, the Board (1) granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1) (2018)) and accepted a stipulation and proposed settlement between the People, Clean Harbors, and Waste Management; (2) ordered Clean Harbors to pay a \$14,750 civil penalty; (3) ordered Waste Management to pay a \$14,750 civil penalty; and (4) ordered Clean Harbors and Waste Management to cease and desist from further violations. Second, upon receiving a stipulation and proposed settlement between the People and the two Aux Sable respondents, along with their agreed motion for relief from the hearing requirement, the Board ordered publication of the required	4-0 roll call vote
PCB 21-1	People of the State of Illinois v. TFC Group, LLC (Air – Enforcement) – In this enforcement action concerning a DuPage County facility, the Board granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1) (2018)), accepted a stipulation and proposed settlement, and ordered TFC Group to pay a \$5,000 civil penalty and to cease and desist from further violations.	4-0 roll call vote
