REPORT OF PROCEEDINGS at the hearing of the above-entitled cause before HEARING OFFICER OFFICER MCCAMBRIDGE, Hearing Officer of said hearing, on November 19th, 2020, at the hour of 11:45 o'clock a.m.


HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: Let's go on the record. My name is Michael McCambridge. I'm the Hearing Officer.

I am remote from home, thanks to our involved situation. This is the hearing in the R21-1 National Ambient Air Quality Standards, NAAQS is the acronym, update for the first half of 2020 from January 1st to June 20th, 2020.

It's noticed here that we have two Board Members -- or three Board Members attending. Could our Board Members identify themselves?

Chairman Currie?
CHAIRMAN CURRIE: I'm Barbara Lynn Currie, and I'm here.

HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: Ms. Santos?
MS. SANTOS: I'm Cynthia Santos, and I'm here. HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: Ms. VanWie?

MS. VAN WIE: This is Jennifer VanWie, and I'm here as well.

HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: Okay. And, again, all participating remotely, thanks to the Internet.

Could persons in the Board Chicago office identify themselves, for the record?

MR. PAULEY: This is Daniel Pauley, staff
attorney, and I'm the only one here.
HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: Staff attorney with the Board. In Springfield, could you identify?

I see we have other people participating, Don Brown, the Clerk of the Board is monitoring this. Essence, could you identify yourself

MS. ESSENCE: I'm Essence Brown from the Tactical Unit of the Board.

HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: Okay. And we have Mark Kaminski. Could you identify yourself, Mark?

MR. KAMINSKI: I'm Mark Kaminski, attorney for the Board, who is also following the hearing.

HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: Venessa, could you identify yourself?

MS. HORTON: My name is Venessa Horton, H-o-r-t-o-n. I'm the attorney advisor for the Board.

HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: Okay. And I see two other persons here. Mr. Davis, could you identify yourself?

MR. DAVIS: I'm Rory Davis with Illinois EPA's Bureau of Air Regulatory Development.

HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: Okay. And Ms. Marzullo?

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THE COURT REPORTER: That's me. I am the court reporter, $\mathrm{M}-\mathrm{a}-\mathrm{r}-\mathrm{z}-\mathrm{u}-\mathrm{l}-\mathrm{l}-\mathrm{O}$.

HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: Very good. I wasn't aware that was you.

Those are all the names that $I$ see on the screen. Is there anyone else that wishes to identify, for the record, that $I$ don't see?

Okay, seeing none, I'll continue. As I said, this is the R21-1 NAAQS Update for the First Half of 2020.

During the first half of the year, USEPA undertook a couple of actions that the Board needs to attend to and one action that the Board does not.

On February 3rd, at 85 Fed. Reg. 5958, USEPA approved a new reference method for sulfer dioxide in ambient air. On May 7th, at 85 Fed. Reg. 27221, USEPA designated a new equivalent method for nitrogen dioxide in ambient air.

The Board has to take action on those two, incorporating those two methods into the Illinois rules. May 26th, 2020, USEPA redesignated the air quality for the Lemont and Pekin areas for containment of the sulfur dioxide on max. The reference on that is 85 Fed . Reg. 31738.

No Board action is required on that. The

Board just took note of it, because it really doesn't change the applicability of any NAAQS within the state. And the final thing that USEPA did on June 15th on 2020, was publish a new list of designated reference and equivalent methods. That new updated list included the methods approved on February 3rd and May 7th.

The Board adopted a proposal for public comment in this on September 17th, 2020. A notice of proposed amendments period in the October 2nd, 2020, Illinois Register, along with -- that was of the reference for that is 44 Illinois Reg. 16081.

Along with the proposed amendments was a notice of public information, giving notice of this hearing, and that was at 44 Illinois Reg. 16378.

Based on the publication date of October 2nd, the 45-day public comment period formally ended on November 16th.

However, because of this hearing, I will extend that public comment period for another two weeks, to give people a chance to react to anything said today, until December 4th.

After December 4th, the Board at some point will consider adopting final amendments. The statutory due date right now for this is

Having said all that $I$ have to say in this matter, does anyone have anything to add?
(Discussion off the record.)
HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: Does anyone --
MS. Godiksen, does the agency have anything to add, to the record?

MS. GODIKSEN: No, we don't.
HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: I'm sorry, you broke up.

MS. GUNNISON: The agency has nothing to add.
HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: Okay. Does
anyone -- any of the Board Members have anything to add?

MS. SANTOS: Not I.
HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: Anyone on Board staff have anything to add?
(No response.)
HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: The nature of these IIS proceeding is that the Board does not engage in substantive review of what USEPA did. Our job is to incorporate USEPA requirements into the Illinois program, so that we can maintain a program that is federally efficient.

And as a result of that, I find myself
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listening to myself more than $I$ wish. So, having said that, again, does anyone have anything to add to the record?
(No response.)
HEARING OFFICER McCAMBRIDGE: Seeing none, we will adjourn this hearing. Thank you. Paper copy submitted to Don brown, the Clerk of the Board.
