Because this rulemaking is not subject to Section 5-35 of the APA, it is not subject to First Notice or to Second Notice review by the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules (JCAR).
- Differences between the proposal and the final version: A table in a document entitled "Identical-in-Substance Rulemaking Addendum (Final)" that the Board added to docket R21-8 summarizes the difference between the amendments adopted in the December 3, 2020 opinion and order and those proposed by the Board in an opinion and order dated September 17, 2020, in docket R21-8.

The differences are limited to minor stylistic revisions. The changes are intended to have no substantive effect.

Have all the changes agreed upon by the Board and JCAR been made as indicated in the agreements issued by JCAR? Section 13.3 of the Environmental Protection Act [415]

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ILCS 5/13.3] provides that Section 5-35 of the Administrative Procedure Act [5 ILCS 100/5-35] does not apply to this rulemaking. Because this rulemaking is not subject to Section 5-35 of the APA, it is not subject to First Notice or to Second Notice review by JCAR.

Since the Notices of Proposed Amendments appeared in the October 2, 2020 issue of the *Illinois Register*, the Board received a suggestion for revision from JCAR. The Board changed the text as a result, as detailed in the Identical-in-Substance Rulemaking Addendum (Final) in docket R21-8 described in item 11 above. A table in the Identical-in-Substance Rulemaking Addendum (Final) in docket R21-8 lists the JCAR suggestion and the Board response.

- Summary and purpose of amendments: The following briefly describes the subjects and issues involved in the docket R21-8 rulemaking. A comprehensive description is contained in the Board's opinion and order of December 3, 2020, adopting amendments in docket R21-8, which opinion and order is available from the address below.

The docket R21-8 proceeding relates to the wastewater pretreatment requirements in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 310 of the Illinois water pollution control rules. This amendment would update the Illinois wastewater pretreatment requirements to correspond with amendments to the federal wastewater pretreatment standards that the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) adopted during the first half of 2020.

The general federal wastewater pretreatment requirements are codified at 40 C.F.R. 403. Federal categorical standards are in parts of 40 C.F.R. 405 through 471. During this period, USEPA amended implementation of its wastewater pretreatment standards as follows:

USEPA updated its NPDES digital reporting rule as it relates to reporting for municipal separate storm sewer systems (MS4s). Some of the MS4-related revisions affected general NPDES digital reporting rules affecting reporting for the wastewater pretreatment program. The Board must incorporate

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these general reporting revisions into the Illinois rules.

The Board deviated from the literal text of the USEPA amendment by using incorporation by reference rather than listing the NPDES digital reporting requirements. Thus, updating the incorporation by reference includes the USEPA action. The further Board removed an obsolete rule relating to USEPA's Project XL and updated incorporations by reference to *Code of Federal Regulations* and *United States Code* provisions to the latest version available.

Tables appear in a document entitled "Identical-in-Substance Rulemaking Addendum (Final)" that the Board added to docket R21-8 that list the revisions to the text since the Board's September 17, 2020 proposal for public comment. The tables contain deviations from the literal text of the federal amendments underlying these amendments, as well as corrections and clarifications that the Board made in the base text involved. Persons interested in the details of those corrections and amendments should refer to the Identical-in-Substance Rulemaking Addendum (Final) in docket R21-8.

Section 13.3 of the Environmental Protection Act [415 ILCS 5/13.3] provides that Section 5-35 of the Administrative Procedure Act [5 ILCS 100/5-35] does not apply to this rulemaking.
