HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On March 31, 2021, petitioner, Ingreidion Incorporated (Ingreidion), filed a Second Joint Motion to Stay Proceedings (Mot.). Ingreidion requests that these proceedings be stayed until December 1, 2021, with the parties filing status reports on or before July 15, 2021, and on or before December 1, 2021. Mot. at 4-5.


It is noted that the Board granted the initial stay on September 19, 2019, with the stay in effect until March 10, 2021, and that the petitioner timely filed all required status reports. *see Ingreidion Incorporated v. IEPA, PCB 19-32, slip op. at 1 (Sept. 19, 2019)*. The Board granted the stay so that additional temperature data from two winter seasons could be collected and analyzed. *Id.* The Board held that the “stay of the temperature water quality standard remains in effect as to Ingreidion during the stay.” *Id.*

Ingreidion states that both parties agree that “with additional consideration of the temperature data gathered during the [initial] stay, and additional analysis of potential language for the NPDES permit with respect to thermal limits, the issue of Ingreidion’s thermal discharge can be addressed through appropriate permit language in the pending NPDES permit renewal”. Mot. at 4.

Ingreidion’s motion is granted. The parties are directed to file a status report on or before July 15, 2021, and again on or before December 1, 2021. The stay of the temperature water quality standard remains in effect as to Ingreidion during the stay.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on April 22, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing. The petitioner has provided a call-in number.


