JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2018).

FACTS

- 1. That Barry D. Ward ("Respondent") is the present owner and operator of a facility located at 65 Payne Drive, in Goreville, Johnson County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Goreville/Ward, Barry D.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 0878555021.
 - 3. That Respondent has owned and operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on February 5, 2021, Gage Shepard of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on April 1, 2021, Illinois EPA hand-delivered this AC to Respondent at 65 Payne Drive, Goreville, Illinois.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Gage Shepard during the course of his February 5, 2021 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

(1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2018).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2018), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than May 11, 2021, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2018), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing

costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2018), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2018). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

Executive Summary

I (Gage Shepard) conducted a follow-up solid waste open dump inspection at the Ward, Barry D. site on February 5, 2021. The address for this site is 65 Payne Drive, Goreville, Illinois 62939. It is in the Eagle Point Bay area in rural Goreville, Johnson County. The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) issued an open dump Administrative Citation Warning Notice (ACWN) on July 17, 2019 based on a June 13, 2019 inspection. The site was reinspected on February 27, 2020, June 5, 2020, and September 23, 2020. This inspection was to assess the progress of the cleanup. It appeared that no progress had been made, and alleged violations continue.

Evaluation Narrative

The site is a residential lot with a parcel identification number of 01-12-213-004. Johnson County Tax Accessor has the owner listed as Barry D. Ward with a site address of 65 Payne Drive in Eagle Point Bay in rural Goreville.

I arrived on-site at 10:39 a.m. and knocked on the door. No one answered the door, so I proceeded to photograph the site. Seven (7) photographs were taken during the February 5, 2021 inspection. Two piles of primarily plastic waste remained north of the residence (photos 2, 5). Household trash remained piled up off the back porch of the house (photo 7). A total of 24 used/waste tires were observed (photos 3, 4, 6). Used/waste tires and other miscellaneous waste remained in the backyard, where the shed used to be (photo 6). Some used/waste tires and a burn barrel were stacked up against the shed north of the house (photo 3). Many of the used/waste tires were holding water (photo 4).


