

BOARD MEETING MINUTES

April 1, 2021

Teleconference

The Board therefore reversed OSFM's June 12, 2018 determination denying Reliable's application for underground storage tank (UST) Fund eligibility and remanded the matter to OSFM to determine Reliable's applicable UST Fund deductible.	4-0 roll call vote
PCB 20-62	Michael J. Korman v. Illinois Department of Transportation (Water, NPDES – Enforcement) – The Board denied IDOT's motions to strike Mr. Korman's bills of particulars and directed Mr. Korman to file an amended complaint by May 3, 2021.	4-0 roll call vote
PCB 21-5	Shree Kuber, Inc. v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (UST Appeal) – The Board granted Shree Kuber's unopposed motions to to supplement the record and to consolidate.	4-0 roll call vote

City of Mount Carmel (Water, NPDES – Enforcement) – In this enforcement action concerning a Wabash County facility, the Board granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1) (2018)), accepted a stipulation and proposed settlement, and ordered the City of Mount Carmel to pay a \$1,620 civil penalty and to cease and desist from further violations.	4-0 roll call vote
