## **HEARING OFFICER ORDER**

On April 1, 2021, the Board directed Korman to file an amended complaint on or before May 3, 2021. Korman v. IDOT, PCB 20-62, slip op. at 6 (April 1, 2021). If Korman fails to file an amended complaint by May 3, 2021, the Board held that "it will consider dismissing the case and closing the docket." *Id.* The Board further held that in the alternative, "Korman may file a motion to dismiss this case and file another complaint." *Id.* 

On May 4, 2021, Korman reported *via* email, that his intention is to not file an amended complaint but file a new complaint to alleviate any service problems.

The parties are directed to participate in a telephonic conference call with the hearing officer on June 3, 2021, at 9:30 a.m. A call-in number will need to be provided by one of the parties. However, if the Board issues a decision prior to the status conference, the conference will be cancelled without further notice.
