ORDER OF THE BOARD (by A. Palivos):

On May 18, 2021, Evelyn M. Page Trust, Wayne A. Page, and Kennard Page, as successor trustees (collectively, the Pages) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal, which concerns an application for payment from the Underground Storage Tank (UST) Fund for the Pages' leaking UST site located at 23907 West Farmington Road in Elmwood, Peoria County. The Pages had filed a petition for review of a determination by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency partially denying the Pages' UST Fund reimbursement request. During the pendency of this appeal, the parties were able to resolve their disagreements and thus the Pages no longer seek to appeal the UST decision. The Board grants the Pages' motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
